

provide a full fellowship. When this occurs, the Graduate School contribution will be reduced. Released Graduate School funds will then be used to match other Wisconsin Distinguished Fellowships.

- The Graduate School portion of the Fellowships will be payrolled on your department's Graduate School payroll (section 35). Contact Bob Banker at 2-4949 with payroll questions.
- Sending out appointment letters to the fellows is a responsibility of the department.
- You must allow at least 12 months from the date your Wisconsin Distinguished Fellowship is **fully** funded at the UW-Foundation before offering a fellowship. It will take at least 12 months and maybe longer to generate the income necessary to cover the department's share (50%) of the fellowship.
