Information for Researchers

As directed by State Statutes [Sec. 94.64 (8m)], the program funds applied soil fertility, soil management or plant nutrition research as these topics relate to the usage of fertilizers or their impacts on surface or groundwater in Wisconsin. The program typically funds 3-5 new proposals each year with annual budgets ranging from \$10,000-45,000. Proposals with annual funding requests in excess of \$50,000 are unlikely to be funded.
